



M.U.S.E. Scholarships 2008-2009

Application Deadline: (for fall 2008): **September 25 (postmarked)**

Applications will not be accepted after this date. Information about the M.U.S.E. Program was distributed in the spring of 2008 for preregistration and will be re-distributed at the beginning of September. M.U.S.E. gives out a limited amount of tuition scholarships. Tuition scholarships are granted up to 50% off of regular tuition cost. Scholarships are determined using the following criteria:

Criteria

1. Based on a first come first serve basis
2. Verification from school administration that parent is in need of financial assistance (this is usually determined if a parent qualifies for free or reduced lunch). *This is all done under complete confidentiality between the director of M.U.S.E. and the principal of the school.*
3. Parents must agree to the following requirements below.

Requirements for Scholarships

1. Tuition payments must be paid on time. 50% of the tuition for the year is due by no later than October 5.
 - A) **FULL TUITION** including materials fee is \$457.00.
 - B) 50% reduction in tuition (including materials/registration fee) is **\$228.50**. This is what you would owe for the entire year of classes.
 - C) **\$114.25 (50% of what your total for the year will be) is due immediately upon acceptance.** If we do not receive this payment by October 5, scholarship may be denied. We do accept credit card payments over the phone.
 - D) The remaining balance: **\$114.25 is due by Dec. 1 (No exceptions). To avoid cancellation of classes, please be on time with your final payment.**

There are no refunds given

2. Student and parent need to agree to a one year commitment (Sept-May).
3. Students must attend classes with instrument regularly.
4. Students need to come to class prepared (minimum of 3-4 days home practice a week).

5. Students need to attend concerts (winter and spring M.U.S.E. concerts and individual school performances).

Attendance and student involvement in preparing for classes is verified/communicated by teacher to the director, Bryant Allard. If any of these requirements are not adhered to, M.U.S.E. has the option to nullify scholarship agreement. M.U.S.E. will contact you as soon as possible after receiving this signed form.
