



Solo and Ensemble Festival

This is a great opportunity for M.U.S.E. Students to gain the experience of preparing a piece of music, performing as either as a soloist or in a small ensemble, and performing in a casual setting. The students will perform their piece to a panel of M.U.S.E. Instructors and then will go to a separate room with an instructor for their evaluation. Parents are invited to both the performance and the evaluation.

Students will be given a 15 minute performance time between 10:00A.M.-2:30P.M. Students performance and evaluation lasts a total of 15 minutes. Student performance schedule will be decided and you will be notified one week before the competition. You may request a specific time. We will try our best to give you your preferred time. Students may perform as an ensemble (2-4 students). If you are performing as an ensemble, you will need to contact the parents of the students involved and decide on a time when all the kids can come. We would suggest that you send your registration form in or register online as soon as possible and specify time. We will do our best to accommodate you. One parent will need to pay the entry fee for the ensemble and work out what each parent owes that parent. All music will either be handed out to students in class and/or posted online for easy download. Teachers will help students decide what the appropriate music would be for their proficiency level.

Awards: All Students will receive participation ribbons. Students are evaluated in 3 different categories: Beginner(under 1 year playing experience), Intermediate(2 years playing experience), Advanced (3 years or more playing experience). Scores also take into account the “difficulty level” assigned to each piece.

Soloists and Ensembles: We will be giving trophies to 1st-5th place overall winners in each category (Beginner,Intermediate, Advanced) as well as medals for 6th-8th Place. **Written evaluations:** All students will receive a written evaluation of their performance.

Cost: There will be an Entry Fee of \$20 per soloist and \$40 per Ensemble. Please send this form with a check (no cash please) to the address below no later than March 29. Make all checks out to M.U.S.E.
